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

If your dream is to ride the mythical Route 66 on a motorcycle but you do not have enough time or money, we propose this option of "HALF" Route 66 starting in Albuquerque and ending in Los Angeles. On this route, you will enjoy the most beautiful area of the USA and, of course, Route 66. We hope you like it.





#### 1 - - Albuquerque -

You arrive in Albuquerque for your first overnight stop. Albuquerque is New Mexico's largest city, home to a third of the state's population. Albuquerque is also sprawling at the heart of New Mexico, where the main east - west road and rail routes cross both the Rio Grande and the old road south to Mexico. Tomorrow morning you will start your ride!



## 2 - Albuquerque - Santa Fe - 104,0 kilómetros

Today, pick up your motorcycles and head for Santa Fe, central New Mexico. Santa Fe is one of America's oldest and most beautiful cities. Here, the most diverse cultures and styles come together.



# 3 - Santa Fe - Gallup - 433,6 kilómetros

This morning you head back to Albuquerque then west out into the open country and the hues of the Navajo wilderness. Further on ride through Grants and along Cibola National Forest towards the famous Route 66 town of Gallup, an old railroad town and Indian stronghold. Enjoy your stay tonight with a host of fellow riders from around the world at one of the many biker friendly hotels in Gallup.



## 4 - Gallup - Flagstaff - 452,8 kilómetros

From Gallup it's only about half an hour to the Arizona border. Once you enter Arizona enjoy a very scenic ride through the Petrified Forest, a fossilized prehistoric forest of giant trees that has been unearthed by erosion. Just west of Petrified National Forest you get to Holbrook and Winslow, two old Route 66 towns that are kept alive by transcontinental truckers. Tonight we will stay in Flagstaff, the northern Arizona community on historic Route 66 and is the regions hub for visits to the Grand Canyon.



#### 5 - Flagstaff - Williams - 412,8 kilómetros

Today you will be able to visit one of the Natural Wonders of the World, the Grand Canyon. The Grand Canyon comprises of layered rocks, cliffs, hills, and valleys and is among the earth's greatest on-going geological spectacles. Today you will have plenty of time to ride along the rim and stop for amazing vistas and photos. Tonight you will overnight in Williams where you can walk, dine and shop in this historic downtown on Route 66.



#### 6 - Williams - Laughlin - 206,4 kilómetros

Cruise down "Memory Lane" and head towards the town of Seligman, one of the longest surviving stretches of the "Mother Road". From Seligman, Route 66 heads off on a northern loop through the Hualapai Indian Reservation and a dozens of quickly fading towns. From Seligman you stay on Route 66 all the way into Kingman. Leaving Kingman, stay on Route 66 via the Oatman Highway. Continue on Route 66 / Oatman Highway as you wind through the canyons surrounded by active and extinct gold mines. The town of Oatman is considered a living Ghost Town. Much of the village stays true to its heritage with staged gunfights and wild burros wandering the streets. Continue to the magical oasis in the dessert, Laughlin.



## 7 - Laughlin - Victorville - 451,2 kilómetros

Today it's off to California, the final state on your ride down legendary Route 66. Ride along the Mojave Desert, which offers some of the most dramatic scenery in Southern California...rolling with lush grasses, startling volcanic formations, large stands of Joshua trees, and even in some Pinyon pines. From the desert you get right into the cool pines of the San Gabriel Mountains. Head for Victorville, which is your base for tonight.



#### 8 - Victorville - Los Angeles - 198,4 kilómetros

Today you are on your way to the final destination of your legendary American road trip, Los Angeles. You head for the end of Route 66 at the Santa Monica Pier. Santa Monica is one of the oldest and largest LA's resorts. Once a wild beachfront playground, it is now a self-consciously liberal and healthy community. Spend the afternoon sightseeing and enjoy Hollywood with the famous Chinese Theatre, Beverly Hills, Rodeo Drive, and much more. Riders always have mixed emotions as they stand at the "End of the Trail" sign on the Santa Monica Pier. There is a sense of joy and elation at having completed a journey most people only dream about, and a sense of sadness at the thought of the ride having come to an end. The great news is that next ride is just a dream away.



### Other information

The hotels will be known 1 month before departure, we always have well-valued 3 or 4 \* hotels. (The hotels that appear in the PDF are indicative)

The US visa must be done electronically at: http://travel.state.gov/visa/visa\_1750.html The entire organization is equipped with telephones. In almost the entire route we will have GSM telephone coverage.

Indispensable mobile phones, tri - bandIn most hotels they have a WI FI connection

The currency is the US dollar. It's easy to find places to change.

Payment with credit cards is very common, VISA, American Express.

To enter the US a digitized passport photo or a biometric passport is required.

To rent a motorcycle you must be 21 years of age and present a valid driver's license.

CANCELLATIONS: Optionally, it offers insurance that covers cancellation expenses in the cases specified in the policy.

The dealership accepts the following credit cards: Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover, Diners, JCB and Traveler's Checks.

The customer is responsible for mechanical damage due to negligence or damage due to lack of review by the customer.

Maintenance Responsibility: The customer is responsible for checking oil and fuel levels and checking gauges if a fault is detected.

Weather and schedules: The weather at this time of year is cool in the East and North. Very warm in the West. On the route we can find some rain sporadically, it is always good to bring a waterproof jacket in case the temperature drops.

Motorcycles: The Harley Davidson Electra model has 2 hard cases + 1 rear trunk.

The model has two RoadKing hard cases and the Heritage Softail has 2 leather saddlebags. Both models have a rear rack where it can be attached to suitable backpack straps.

All the models described have support, and the shield, in the case of each driver this support can be removed.

Informative briefing: When you pick up the motorcycle, you will be given an explanation about it, which includes safety instructions, maintenance problems by the client and local driving regulations.

LANGUAGESThe national language is English

HEALTH: We recommend a kit with:- Eye drops. - Aspirin- Antidiarrheals- Adhesive tape and bandages-Sunscreen

We have to give a minimum of 10% tip as it is actually your salary. If we believe that we have given a good service, the tip can be up to 20%

DRIVING It is very important to respect all traffic signs and drive correctly and without recklessness.

CLOTHING: The rental includes a helmet. It is possible to buy new helmets at the dealer or that you bring from your country. We recommend the use of technical and waterproof clothing in case it rains. We rent leather jackets \$10 / day.

Harley pick-up and drop-off: Pick-up: from 9 am Drop-off: until 4:30 p.m. There is a surcharge of 25 dollars / hour of delay. There are no cash payments, in the case of early return.

Documentation: To facilitate the management of your collection of motorcycles, we would need the "customer service form" that we will enclose and must be returned when it is finished and at least 15 days before the departure of your flight.
